#### **Cohort Profile**

- Average points score on entry was 27.7 compared to the national average of 27.6.
- Girls APS was 28.5 compared to boys APS of 26.9.

#### **Headline Figures**

- **70%** 5 or more GCSE equivalent A\* C passes.
- **57%** achieved 5 or more A\*-C passes, including maths and English, below the target of 63%.
- 97% achieved 5 or more A\*-G grades.
- **74%** made expected progress in English.
- 64% made expected progress in maths.
- **17%** achieved the EBACC.
- **15.64%** achieved 5 or more A\*/ A grades.
- Projected VA **1014.62**.

#### **Capped Points Score (capped APS)**


A pupil's performance in their best 8 qualifications is expressed as a point score. Subject point score calculations will change next year. However, currently the highest value is 58 points for an A\* and dropping by 6 points per grade.

#### Value Added


The purpose of a value added measure is to estimate how individual pupils progressed in relation to their peers between KS2 and KS4. This is used for comparing progress of pupils between schools.



Median trend lineMaximum capped


#### **SEND Students**

There were 25 students (14%) on the SEN register with 20% of this cohort achieving 5A\*-C including English and maths.





#### **Pupil Premium Cohort**


There were 44 (24.6%) students in the PP cohort. The pupil premium measure identifies students who are either entitled to FSM or have been in the previous 6 years, are looked after or are from families within the armed forces.




#### **Attainment on entry**

From 2011 onwards, the attainment band on entry (level 3, level 4 or level 5) has been included in performance tables:






#### Level 4 on entry (Middle)




#### Level 5 on entry (High)



#### **Gender Difference**

Whilst there is a gap between the attainment of boys and girls of 12.94% 5A\* - C including English and maths this is greater than the national picture of 11%. In addition the attainment of boys and girls is higher than the national average.
