The **energy networks** play a vital role in all of our lives - from the moment the alarm goes off and we jump in the shower, until the time we switch the lights off at night. Every minute of every day the cables running over our heads and the pipes lying beneath our feet, run the electricity and gas to homes and businesses across the UK.

The **networks employ over 28,000 people** who together look after the 1 million km of electricity cables and 272,000 km of gas pipes. However the networks will soon face a skills shortage where estimates suggest they will need to recruit over 11,000 people by 2022 to ensure these vast networks continue to meet demand.

As part of the forthcoming Low Carbon Network & Innovation Conference, some of the UK's network operators will be hosting the Networks Careers Event, taking place on the morning of Thursday 26 November at the ACC Liverpool.

The **Network Careers Event** will give students and graduates the opportunity to meet with gas and electricity network operators to learn about what the networks do and to discuss future employment opportunities within this exciting sector.

Attendees will learn about the benefits of working in a sector that offers its employees diverse working environments, competitive salaries, secured long term employment and involvement in cutting edge technology and innovation.

Network Statistics

The electricity network in Great Britain is over 1 million km long and could circle the equator twenty five times... whilst gas is carried along 272,000km of pipes, which could go around the world six times.

The networks serve over 30 million electricity customers and 22.5 million gas customers.

Every year 4,200km of gas mains are replaced, the equivalent of Britain's entire motorway network.
