Task 1

There are many different words that we use to describe the past. It is important that we understand these words if we are to become good historians. Sort out the correct heads and tails.

HEADS	TAILS
Century	Anno Domini, these Latin words mean after Christ.
A.D.	One thousand years
Decade	Separate division of time
Periods	Before Christ
B.C.	One hundred years
Millennium	Every ten years

Task 2

You will need to be able to put dates into the correct century. There is a special rule to help you work this out.

Step one: Take off the last 2 numbers of the year

Step two: add one E.g. 1342 = 13 + 1 = 14 So, 1342 is in the 14th Century
