As a part of your child's education at Hawkley Hall High School we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. PSHE education is the curriculum subject that gives young people the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

I am writing to let you know that the changes to statutory requirements to PSHE means that we will be sharing the programme to ensure that you are aware of when your child's education will be taking part in lessons which will focus on the relationships and sex education (RSE) aspect of this programme. RSE lessons in all year groups will include teaching about healthy relationships, including friendships and intimate relationships; families; growing and changing, including puberty; changing feelings; becoming more independent; keeping safe and consent; developing self-esteem and confidence. Pupils will also have opportunities to ask questions that help prepare them for relationships of all kinds in the modern world.

PSHE is taught throughout the school in every year group and is monitored and reviewed regularly by the staff and governing body. Please visit the school's website for more detail about our PSHE curriculum where the programme for each year group is available. All PSHE teaching takes place in a safe learning environment and is underpinned by our school ethos and values.

We will be inviting you to attend a parent information meeting later in the year to find out more about what your child will learn, view the materials and resources being used in lessons and discover how you can best support your child to discuss these topics at home.
