Friday 11 <sup>th</sup> July 2025	<p>Good Afternoon</p> <p>As you know Friday 18th July 2025 is our final day of the summer term, during this day we will be holding an assembly with all students to celebrate the achievements that we have made collectively as a school community. Please encourage your child to attend every day up to and including Friday.</p> <p>On Friday, school will finish at approx. 12:15pm and the buses will run as normal at this time. As predicted, we are having some lovely warm weather and so we have allowed students to remove their blazer/jumper as they move around our school. We have asked the following;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Blazers and jumpers should be carried or placed in bags and not tied around students’ waists</li> <li>2) Top buttons must be fastened with ties on properly and shirts tucked in</li> <li>3) Students should wear their full school uniform to school each day.
